Bruce Power selects Acres - Sargent & Lundy - Fox Joint Venture to support Bruce A Units 1 & 2 Restart Project

Oakville – October 17, 2005 — A joint venture of Acres-Sargent & Lundy (Oakville, Ont.) and E.S. Fox Ltd. (Niagara Falls, Ont.), known as ASLF, has been selected to support the Bruce A Units 1 & 2 Restart Project. ASLF will provide engineering and construction services to upgrade existing fire protection systems and install a new station secondary control facility. The joint venture will work as an integrated team with Bruce Power in its \$4.25 billion investment program, part of which is the restart of Units 1 and 2 at its Bruce A Nuclear Generating Station in Tiverton, Ontario, Canada.

As described in Bruce Power's news release (www.brucepower.com) announcing the project, plans for the restart of Bruce A Units 1 and 2 will begin immediately with the first unit expected to be back online in 2009.
